

The Greenway



St. Vincent Greenway is a linear park being developed and constructed by Great Rivers Greenway, the organization leading the development of the region-wide system of greenways, parks and trails in St. Louis City, St. Louis County and St. Charles County.

St. Vincent Greenway will extend seven miles beginning at the north end in North Park, through the University of Missouri-St. Louis campus, through St. Vincent County Park, then through Pagedale and Wellston. The greenway enters the City of St. Louis at Skinker Boulevard and Etzel Avenue, continuing through Ruth Porter Mall Park, then travels south on DeBaliviere Avenue to Forest Park to the Missouri History Museum entrance.

WHO WE ARE



St. Vincent Greenway, Inc. is a nonprofit organization pioneering a new model for cross-community development, bridging economic, social, and jurisdictional divides by executing programs and initiatives that impact the lives of those who reside, work and play along St. Vincent Greenway. **Our mission is to transform the Greenway vicinity into a socially and economically viable and mutually supportive group of communities.** These are places where individuals feel connected to one another and have adequate access to employment and a healthy environment.



Here's a snapshot of our programs...

- **Jazz on the Greenway** - an annual community fair with live music, food and dance vendors, and children's activities.
- **Work Play Day** - a service day devoted to the beautification of green spaces and fun physical activity.
- **Imagine the Greenway Tour** - a guided bike tour of the greenway with a focus on specific themes and communities.
- **Virtual Incubator and Business Association** - a support network for local entrepreneurs and potential entrepreneurs who wish to start or grow their businesses in the greenway vicinity.
